# Linda Caron your MMA

#### Dear Neighbours,

The year 2025 marks the 85th anniversary of women's right to vote and eligibility to run as candidates in Quebec. Knowing how long and arduously women fought to obtain those rights, I feel all the more honoured to be your Member of National Assembly (MNA).

Whenever I walk past the Monument in Tribute to Women in Politics, on the western side of Parliament Building, I am reminded of the admirable, courageous, and tenacious trailblazers to whom it pays homage: Marie Lacoste-Gérin-Lajoie, Idola Saint-Jean, Thérèse Casgrain, and Marie-Claire Kirkland, the latter being the first woman elected to the National Assembly, in 1961.

Unveiled in 2012, this monument in their honour owes its conception notably to a former MNA for La Pinière, Mrs. Fatima Houda-Pepin, who presided over the implementation committee for the work of sculptor Jules Lasalle.

I hope to see you this summer in the riding of La Pinière, or to welcome you for a chat at my office.

### Subsidy for our Library

I am happy to report that I managed to convince the Minister of Culture and Communications to free up a subsidy of more than \$2.1 million for the Georgette-Lepage Library here in La Pinière. This subsidy accounts for 50% of the total cost of the project, which seeks to renovate the roof, replace mechanical equipment, and refurbish the ground floor. This project will also allow for the installation of self-checkout machines, smart drop-off technology, a sorting conveyor, and new furniture.

### Parliamentary Nork

Throughout the 2024-2025 parliamentary session, I made several declarations to highlight landmark moments, such as Black History Month, and milestones like the 25th anniversary of both Good Shepherd Leisure Group and FORMATIO. I also made declarations to raise awareness for arthritis, caregiving, intermediary resources, and visual handicaps.


On October 1, 2024, I tabled a motion adopted unanimously to high-light the International Day of Older Persons. I stressed how the importance of combatting ageism, isolation and mistreatment, as well as offering all seniors the opportunity to live with dignity, is a collective responsibility.

In addition to budget appropriations, I sat on parliamentary committees and intervened on several bills, notably Bill 67 amending the Professional Code, Bill 68 on reducing doctors' administrative tasks, Bill 73 tackling the non-consensual sharing of intimate images, Bill 82



on the creation of a new national digital identity, Bill 83 on medical practice in our health and social services system, and Bill 100 on negotiations in public and semi-public sectors.

I also tabled a petition signed by 3,380 people demanding the government respect its repeated promise to proceed with an expansion project for the Bedford CHSLD in the Eastern Townships. Unfortunately, the government preferred to renege on its promise.



#### Local Resources and Activities for Seniors

Many of you have asked me where to find services and activities for seniors in the riding of La Pinière. My team drew up a list of organizations offering such services or activities to keep seniors active both physically and socially. After reaching out to these organizations to get their permission, we created a free guide, available at our riding office and on my website at www.lindacaron.ca.


